NOTICE TO HEIRS AND LEGATEES

Within 42 days after the effective date of the original order of admission, any heir or legatee may file a petition with the court to require proof of the will by testimony of the witnesses to the will in open Court or other evidence as provided in section 6-21 of the Probate Act of 1975. (755 ILCS 5/6-21)

You also have the right under section 8-1 of the Probate Act of 1975 (755 ILCS 5/8-1) to contest the validity of the will by filing a petition with the Court within 6 months after the admission of the will after probate.

Attached to this notice are copies of a petition to probate a will and an order denying admission of the will to probate. You are named in the petition as an heir or legatee of the decedent.

You have a right under section 8-2 of the Probate Act of 1975 (755 ILCS 5/8-2) to contest the denial of admission by filing a petition with the Court within 6 months after entry of the order of denial.
