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DUPAGE COUNTY SENIOR CITIZEN SERVICES



DuPage County Senior Citizen Services works with persons 60 and older to help them maintain their independence as they are faced with the challenges of aging. The Illinois Department on Aging has selected Senior Citizen Services as the Case Coordination Unit for DuPage County. In addition to this directory, our unit also publishes the Senior Citizens Resource Directory and Long Term Care Facilities booklet.

The following describes our various services and programs:

Information and Referral: Information is provided to seniors and their families on services and benefits available. Clients are then linked with the appropriate resources to meet their needs.

Community Care Program: Provides subsidized homemaker, adult day care and emergency home response services to eligible seniors.

Case Management: Complete in-home assessments to determine the needs of individuals requesting assistance and arrange for appropriate services. Follow-up and monitoring are provided.

Home Delivered Meals: Staff coordinates intakes and provides assessments for homebound seniors who are unable to prepare meals or visit a congregate meal site because of an illness or disability. Eligible seniors can receive a nutritious, hot meal.

Elder Abuse and Neglect Program: Case Managers respond to all reports of elder abuse, neglect, and exploitation, and work with the older person to resolve the abusive situation.

Long Term Care Ombudsman Program: Offers assistance to or on behalf of residents aged 60 and over who reside in a Long Term Care Facility.

Outreach: Visits seniors in their homes who need information and individualized assistance in accessing available resources.

Choices for Care Screenings: A consultation is provided to nursing facility applicants to help them discover their options for long term care. An assessment of needs is completed. Information on alternative home and community-based services is provided that may prevent premature nursing facility placement.

Family Caregiver Support Program: Provides information and assistance, respite services and emergency support to caregivers of older persons and grandparents raising grandchildren.

Where To Begin?

There are many housing options available to older adults residing in the DuPage County area. Selecting the most appropriate housing arrangement can be a challenging and critical decision. It is very important to begin your search with an accurate understanding of your current abilities and needs with consideration for how these needs may change with age. This will empower you to select housing that will provide the right balance of support and independence.

If you are unsure of the type of housing that would be most appropriate, you may want to have a case manager complete an assessment and provide guidance in the housing selection process. This is a service available to you through the Dupage County Senior Services' Choices for Care Program as well as through private case management agencies.

It is common in this directory to find senior housing that includes some support service or subsidy. To simplify your use of this directory while providing the information you need, we have categorized the options available. Examples are **Subsidized Housing**, offering reduced rents, some sites may provide limited services...**Shared Housing**, creative alternatives where 2 or more adults share a home or apartment...**Supportive Living**, subsidized housing with comprehensive services...**Independent-Assisted Living**, complexes that offer varying levels of support up to, but not including, skilled nursing care at full market rates...**Continuing Care Retirement Communities**, providing a place to live with graduated support for as long as you live, including skilled nursing care. Preceding each of the following sections of this guide you will find more complete descriptions of the accommodations provided.

Additional Housing Information and Assistance

While we attempt to offer accurate and comprehensive information, doing so is an ongoing task. Additional lists, **Fair Market Value Rentals** and **Long Term Care Facilities** are also available upon request. Staff is available to provide guidance on housing issues such as fair housing law, landlord/tenant rights, evictions, and foreclosures. Emergency rental assistance is also available to those who qualify.

Choosing a New Residence

Many factors contribute to making a good move. Consider the following as you prepare for the change:

Location: Family, friends and other community supports become even more important as we age.

- ✓ Is the residence within a reasonable distance of family and friends?
- ✓ Can I get to my doctors or house of worship easily?
- ✓ What kind of transportation is available?

Staff: The people who serve us can make us feel welcome or ill at ease in very subtle ways. Pay attention to how you feel while touring the residence and meeting the staff. The manager generally sets the tone for the performance of others.

- ✓ What interactions can I expect with staff? What capacity do they serve and do they appear trained, attentive, friendly and respectful?
- ✓ What hours is staff available?
- ✓ What is the protocol for lodging complaints?
- ✓ What is the turnover rate for staff leaving?

Layout and accommodations: Comfort in our surroundings and ease of access to services we need profoundly affect our sense of well being.

- ✓ What are the meal options, where and how are they served?
- ✓ Are the indoor and outdoor surroundings attractive, clean and well maintained?
- ✓ What are the parking accommodations for my guests and me?
- ✓ Are the entrances and common areas accessible to the disabled?
- ✓ What amenities are important? Gift shop, beauty or barbershop, exercise room, library, and laundry facilities?
- ✓ What activities are promoted and provided?

Apartment: This is your haven and must have a feeling of “home” in it.

- ✓ Is it the right size for the belongings you need to be comfortable?
- ✓ What utilities are provided? Phone, cable, emergency response mechanism?
- ✓ Is it attractive to you?
- ✓ What appliances are included? Refrigerator, microwave, stove, washer and dryer?
- ✓ Would you have room for a guest or are there other guest accommodations available?

Financial/contractual: It is extremely important to understand what you will be getting for your money and what obligations you are committing yourself to. Never commit impulsively: read the fine print and understand it before signing anything.

- ✓ What fees are required up front and under what circumstances are they refundable?
- ✓ What specifically is included in the basic cost?
- ✓ What are the fees for additional services?
- ✓ How are fees billed?
- ✓ Is home health care available and what payment is accepted, i.e. Medicare, private insurance, etc.?
- ✓ If a contract is required, how is it terminated?

Safety considerations: You and your family need to have a sense of security.

- ✓ What monitoring is performed at the residence on a regular basis?
- ✓ Who has access to your apartment or room?
- ✓ What security staff is provided and when?
- ✓ Is there staff certified in CPR?
- ✓ What is the evacuation plan in case of a fire? Are there alarm and sprinkler systems? Where are the fire extinguishers
- ✓ To what hospital would you be transported in an emergency?
- ✓ Where are medical records, Living Wills and Power of Attorney's kept? Who has access to them?
- ✓ Is the room, apartment and building clean, free of odors, and clutter free?

Subsidized Housing

Subsidized Senior Apartments – Subsidized housing is provided in two ways, through a project-based subsidy or through a voucher program. These are both federally funded programs that assist low income people afford decent rental housing. The amount you will pay for rent in both cases is calculated as approximately 30% of your gross income with some consideration given for medical expenses as well.

The voucher program is offered to individuals through the DuPage Housing Authority. The application and enrollment procedures are lengthy. Once a voucher is obtained, however, it is transferable from one approved location to another and is renewable annually. There are times when the waiting list for these vouchers is so long that the list is temporarily closed. For more information, please call the DuPage Housing Authority at (630) 690-3555.

Project-based subsidies are available through the management offices of specific complexes. You must apply directly to the apartment building that you are interested in. The waiting list for these can be lengthy as well but we encourage you to apply even if you don't think you can wait that long. The subsidy remains with the building and cannot be transferred. Below is a list of complexes in DuPage County offering subsidized units to seniors. The information contained is subject to change and we suggest you contact the individual management offices for current status.

Type of Rooms/Apt: Types of residences vary, but clients will have their own bedroom, shared access throughout common areas of the household.

Waiting List: No formal waiting list; the length of time before placement is achieved is dependent on the number of available providers, and the successful matching of mutual compatibilities, and the chemistry between the provider and the seeker.

Fees: There are no sign up or administrative fees. Contributions towards household expenses are routinely modest in comparison to Fair Market Value rental rates, and in some instances, contributions to household expenses can be negotiated significantly downwards in return for modest services.

Accessible to Disabled: Dependent upon the home provider's accommodations.

Amenities/Services Provided: The Case Manager interviews all applicants to determine their individual wants, needs, likes and dislikes, and then performs background, and personal reference checks. When participants mutually agree to share with each other, they will determine whether or not they want to be case managed. The Case Manager provides guidance, assistance, support, and advocacy before, during and after a match is made.

Age Requirements: None

Supportive Living Facilities (SLF)

SLF living offers the frail elderly a “housing with services” option not previously available for Medicaid-eligible individuals. It is an attractive alternative to traditional nursing facility care that integrates subsidized housing and support services. Medicaid reimburses for an array of services, including meals, personal care, homemaking, laundry, medication supervision, social activities, recreation and 24-hour, on-site staff to meet residents’ scheduled and unscheduled needs.

The Supportive Living Program is open to any resident whom:

- Is 65 or older, and undergoes preadmission screening and demonstrates appropriate need for care;
- Is without a primary or secondary diagnosis of mental illness or developmental disability;
- Is certified by a physician as requiring the level of care provided by a SLF
